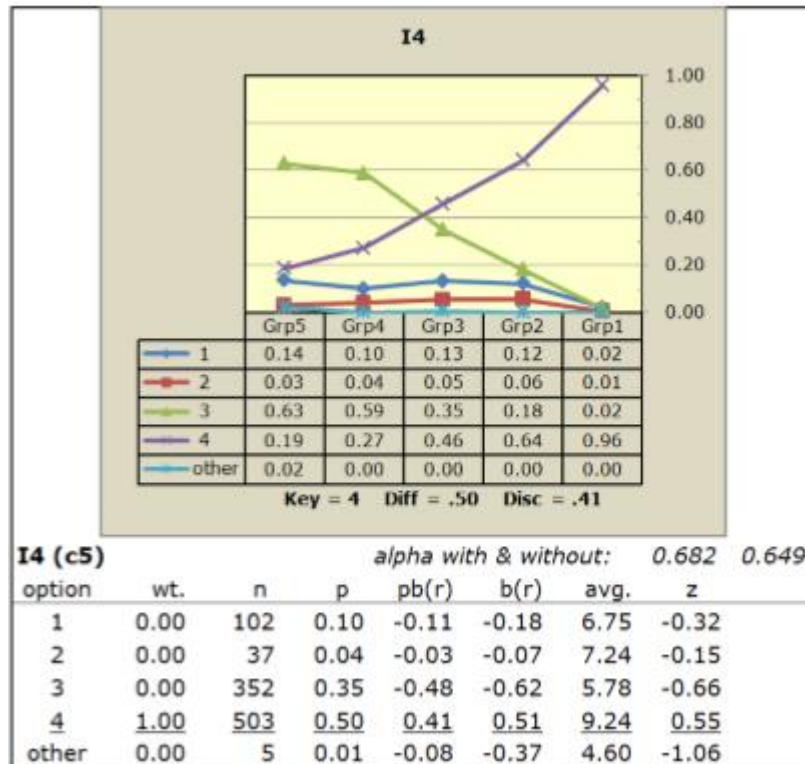


January 2015 Lertap Notice for Version 5.10.5

This document last updated: 28 January 2015

Just a note to say that Lertap 5.10.5 is now available for Windows users with Excel 2010 or Excel 2013, and also to wish y'all a happy, healthy, and hopefully prosperous new year.

The main feature of this new version: substantially enhanced item response charts, such as those seen in "quintile plots". The charts may now have data from [Stats1f](#) included, as exemplified:



The number of quantiles was limited to a maximum of 5 before; that's been increased to 10. A print controller may be activated so that these new quantiles do not get split at the bottom of a printed page. And, it's still possible to get just the plot with no associated data tables if wanted; or, on the other hand, even more data may appear below the plot if an external criterion score has been used.
